

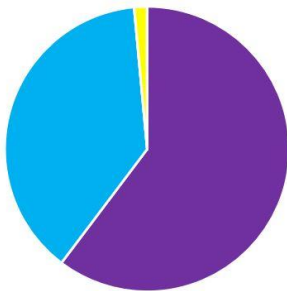


St. Mary's Community Primary School

Parent Survey – February 2021

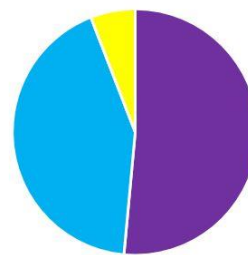
In February, following a period of remote learning, we asked our parents for their opinions on how we were doing as a school. More than 50% of our families responded and we were thrilled with the positive feedback.

Communication during lockdown has been clear



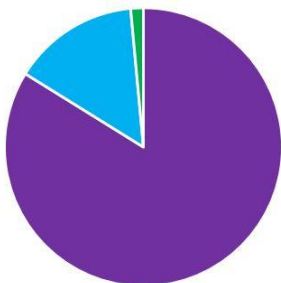

My child understands their teacher's expectations regarding remote learning



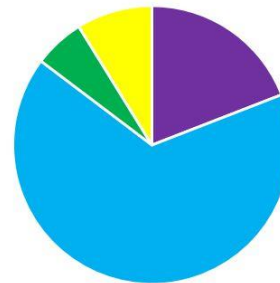

The amount of work assigned each day...



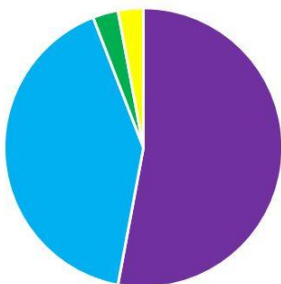
■ Is about right ■ Is too much ■ Is too little

Generally my child finds the work engaging



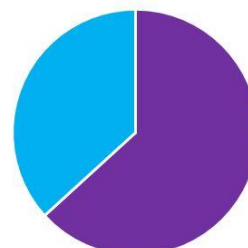

My child receives good feedback on their work



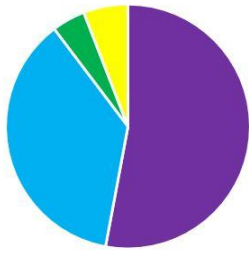

I am able to communicate with school and my child's teacher



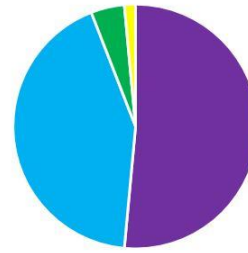

I clearly understand the school's expectations of my role as a parent regarding home learning



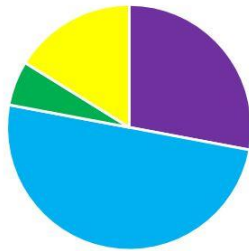

The resources required for home learning are easily accessible



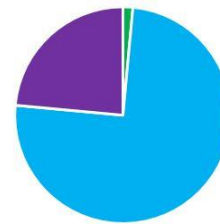

Some comments from our families . . .

I don't feel like the school could do anything to improve home learning it's just a hard time for everyone and occasionally we have to stop work and have a breather then come back to it.
