

## Status Monitor Levels

These are the possible levels of alert you may receive about the status of each bubble. You can use this information to make informed decisions for your family.

**Date: Thursday, 19 November 2020**

<b>Outbreak</b>	The school have declared an outbreak with the Norfolk Outbreak Management Team. We will send you a letter explaining what actions to take.
<b>Confirmed Case</b>	There is a confirmed case or confirmed cases in this bubble. We will send you a letter explaining what actions to take.
<b>Possible Case</b>	This means that someone in the year group bubble is awaiting a test or test results. <b>OR</b> Someone in the year group has been told to self-isolate due to a close contact having a positive test result.
<b>We are not aware of any suspected cases</b>	This doesn't mean there are definitely not any Covid cases in the bubble, it means we don't know of anyone awaiting a test or a test result.
